

Teaching Credits for NIH Speakers:

For NIH speakers interested in receiving teaching credits, you can apply to the AMA by completing their Direct Credit Application. For AMA-approved activities that have taken place within the past three years that were not sponsored by Johns Hopkins, you may obtain teaching credit directly from the AMA, since Hopkins cannot issue credit for those activities. The AMA offers two hours credit per hour of instruction, and you must include a copy of the program or brochure, accredited provider information, list of speakers, date and location.
